What is the primary goal of the Restoration Project?

To help men who have sexually offended become healthy, safe and productive members of their family, church and community.

Who should attend the Restoration Project?

Men who have sexually offended. The majority of men in our program have offended children by manipulating or forcing a child's involvement in sexual behaviors which include but are not limited to the following: sexual penetration, fondling of a child, use of pornography with a child, exposing self to a child, or having a child perform sexual acts.

Does Restoration Project collaborate with Probation if necessary?

Yes, in fact, many of our referrals come from county probation officers. Please note that men are not required to share the Christian faith of CRC to be clients or to graduate from treatment.

I served my time in jail, spent 3½ years in the CRC's Project Restoration. And now after five years, I've moved back into my home and reunited with my family. It's a miracle of miracles."

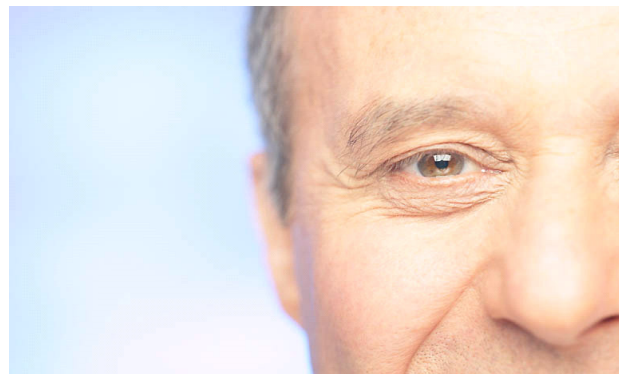
